Forest City started this summer and has been adding a new mom every meeting. We are up to seven moms at the writing of this newsletter. We are needing more mentor moms to join the team.

One mom attends our Algona community group, which started this fall. This has allowed us to have one-on-one discipleship with her. She is a new believer and newly returned to the area. After meeting with the Care Team, we are hopeful to see an increase in participation by other moms.

Part of being the Executive Director means talking to others about the ministry of SMILE. It has been a blessing to speak to churches, do radio interviews, meet with other organizations, and have a booth at expos. Our eyes are on a property which has potential. We would like to be able to purchase the property without struggling to find the funds. Then we will look forward to building the community. We know that God in His perfect sovereignty will bring all things to fruition in His perfect timing.
